One of the biggest entertainment-for-good events, Guestlist4Good, is scheduled for December 2 and 3 at Mumbai's Dr DY Patil Stadium. Shailendra Singh's brainchild is gearing up to create history by educating 1, 00,000 underprivileged kids on Magic Bus. The event was inceptioned as a reaction to a 2015 headline which claimed that 84 million Indian children do not attend school.

"We are uniting the world through music for the benefit of Indian children," says Shailendra, adding, "Music has the power to unite and change the world. It's a moment of pride for India that we are putting aside all

our differences, and thinking about the future of our nation."

In order to fulfil their vision of providing every Indian child with the education he or she deserves, the event has partnered with one of the largest poverty alleviation programmes in India that currently works with 4,00,000 children and 8000 trained volunteer mentors.

"Through the first two Guestlist events with Shailendra, we have been able to educate 28,200 children. It's a brilliant combination of entertainment and awareness about a cause that can empower the new, young India to have a positive social impact," says Mathew Spacie, the founder of the program for kids.
